

Guidelines for Contributors

Libri & Liberi is a peer-reviewed academic journal published twice a year in printed and electronic form by the Croatian Association of Researchers in Children's Literature.

Expected contributions

Libri & Liberi publishes academic papers which have not been previously published or submitted to other publications at the same time. Papers presented at a conference, which are not to be published in conference proceedings, may also be considered.

Authors are also invited to submit book reviews.

Submitted articles will be reviewed by two or more independent referees and the authors will be given feedback within six months of submission.

Potential authors are invited to contact the Editor-in-Chief at librietliberi@gmail.com or at narancic-kovac@ufzg.hr to discuss the paper proposal before the final submission.

Submission guidelines

Manuscripts are to be submitted to librietliberi@gmail.com. The text should generally not be more than 8000 words long, including tables and references.

Illustrations and photographs should be submitted in separate files. The preferred formats are tiff and jpg. High quality paper copies of illustrations may be needed for scanning. Copyright clearance needs to be obtained by the author.

A separate **front page** of the paper should include the title, full name and title of the author, affiliation, and contact details (email address, mailing address and phone number). If there are more authors, the required data should be included for each of them. The title must be repeated on the following page.

The **language** of the submitted papers may be English, German or Croatian. Potential authors should consult the Editor-in-Chief if they intend to submit articles in other languages.

Language accuracy and appropriateness is the responsibility of the author.

An **abstract** of up to 150 words should clearly state the problem addressed by the paper, and include the results, main observations and conclusion. The abstract should be submitted in the same language as the paper, as well as in English if the paper is written in German or Croatian. If the paper is in English, the abstract will be translated into Croatian and German by *Libri & Liberi*.

Six **keywords** should be listed in alphabetical order in a separate paragraph, in the same language as the abstract.

The manuscript should be submitted as a **Word** document and also as a PDF file.

The **text** should be paginated, and the font should be Times New Roman. Font size of 12 points and a spacing of 1.5 should be used. Paragraphs need to be clearly separated. The title must be given in font size of 14 points. The title and the headings should be bolded.

References are cited in the text by name of author, year of publication, and page references, e.g. (Surname yyyy: p) or (Surname and Surname yyyy: pp).

A list of references at the end of the paper should include full bibliographic details of all references in alphabetical order of authors' surnames and in chronological order for a single author. Full authors' names need to be included. For example:

Books:

Surname, Name. yyyy. *Title*. City: Publisher.

Surname, Name, Name Surname, Name Surname & Name Surname. yyyy. *Title: Subtitle*.
City: Publisher.

Edited books:

Surname, Name, ed. yyyy. *Title: Subtitle*. City: Publisher.

Surname, Name & Name Surname, eds. yyyy. *Title*. City & City: Publisher.

Chapter in a book:

Surname, Name. yyyy. Chapter Title. In *Book Title*, ed. Name Surname, p–p. City: Publisher.

Surname, Name. yyyy. Chapter Title. In *Book Title*, eds. Name Surname et al, p–p. City:
Publisher.

Paper or summary in a book of proceedings (or a talk delivered at a conference/congress)

Surname, Name. yyyy. Title of Paper, Summary or Talk. In *Proceedings Title*, ed. Name Surname, Name Surname & Name Surname, p–p. City: Publisher. Type of source [e.g. Book of Abstracts / Proceedings of] Conference description *Conference Title/Topic/Theme* (if different from the publication title) [e.g. The 3rd Congress of the Association xxx (on) *New Research in....*] or a public event, Principal organising institution, City where it was held, State, dd – dd Month yyyy.

Paper in a journal

Surname, Name. yyyy. Paper Title. *Journal Name* Vol (issue/No): p–p.

Web page, paper on a web page/site and other internet sources:

Page owner. *Page Name*. <http:page_address/> (accessed d Month yyyy).

Surname, Name. yyyy. Paper Title. *Web Page/Site Name*. <http:page_address/> (accessed d Month yyyy).
